Topics range from basic bird biology, identification and ecology, to bird conservation service-learning activities. The program promotes greater environmental stewardship through monitoring projects and exciting bird festivals that are organized by the students for their friends, school or community.



Developed under the guidance of environmental education professionals and wildlife conservation organizations, Flying WILD activities have been field tested in classrooms across the nation.

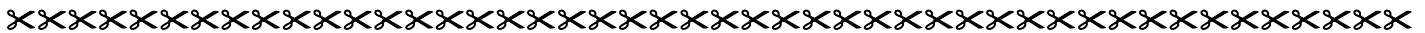
